LONG TITLE: Concerning the dollar amount of a special district contract that requires notice for bids.

SHORT TITLE: Special District Construction Contract

SPONSORS: Representatives Lindstedt and Wilson/Senators Roberts and Gardner

COMMITTEES: House Transportation, Housing & Local Government Committee

PURPOSE OF THE BILL: To increase the threshold amount of construction contracts being let by a special district before they are required to put out for public bid. It appears to respond to inflationary influences.

PROPOSERS OF THE BILL: Special districts

POTENTIAL STAKEHOLDERS: The press association, construction companies, labor, taxpayer groups, special districts who undertake construction projects.

Is this bill necessary this year? There is no deadline.

BACKGROUND: N/A

How does the bill change current law? It doubles the amount of a contract before it becomes necessary to publish the opportunity to bid.

Does the bill affect the prior appropriations system? No

How is the bill implemented? It appears to be self-executing, although an individual district may need to alter its bylaws and procedures for publishing opportunities to bid.
