

<u>SB19-212</u>

SHORT TITLE: Appropriation General Fund Implement State Water Plan

LONG TITLE: Concerning general fund support to implement the state water plan, and, in connection therewith, making an appropriation

SPONSORS: Senators Rankin, Moreno and Zenzinger/Reps. Esgar and Hansen

COMMITTEES: Senate Appropriations Committee

PURPOSE OF THE BILL: To provide money from the state General Fund to support implementation of the State Water Plan

PROPONENTS OF THE BILL: JBC bill responding to request by former Governor Hickenlooper

POTENTIAL STAKEHOLDERS: Water users

Is this bill necessary this year? Yes, if implementation of the Water Plan is to be meaningful.

BACKGROUND: Governor Hickenlooper had requested \$30 million for implementation of the State Water Plan covering a three-year period. Due to a reduced economic forecast, the JBC provided \$10 million funding from the General Fund for the current year. The money is divided into a grant program to be administered by CWCB of \$8.3 million and \$1.7 million to the department for use by the board for stakeholder outreach and technical analysis to develop a water resources demand management program.

How does the bill change current law? Provides money from the General Fund for water projects.

Does the bill affect the prior appropriations system? No.

How is the bill implemented? This bill is part of a budget package of legislation to implement funding made through the Long Appropriations Bill.

Practical considerations: Where do we find the additional money needed for future water spending?

Fiscal Impact: \$10 million.
