SHORT TITLE: PFAS Polyfluoroalkyl Substances Manufacturer Notice Requirements

LONG TITLE: Concerning a modification of the notice requirements for manufacturers of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances.

SPONSORS: Reps. D. Valdez and McKean/Sens. Moreno and Tate

COMMITTEES: House Transportation & Local Government Committee

PURPOSE OF THE BILL: To correct an error in legislation enacted in 2019 which required manufacturers to notify sellers of PFAS regulations one year prior to their effective date (August 2, 2019) That requirement was impossible because the regulations did not exist one year prior. The bill changes the effective date of the notice to August 2, 2020..

PROPONENTS OF THE BILL: Legislative statutory revision committee

POTENTIAL STAKEHOLDERS: PFAS manufacturers and sellers

BACKGROUND: Legislation was enacted in 2019 setting forth various requirements dealing with PFAS. One requirement was that manufacturers notify sellers of the new regulations one year prior to their effective date. That was impossible, therefore the effective date is being moved to August. 2, 2020.

Is this bill necessary this year? Yes

How does the bill change current law? It moves the effective date of the regulations to a time that will allow manufacturers to comply with the law.

Does the bill affect the prior appropriations system? No

How is the bill implemented? It moves the effective date
